

POWERSENSE HONOURED WITH THE PRESTIGE MEDAL OF HONOUR



Sydney, Australia, Monday 21 November, 2011 - The Sydney based branch office of the Danish cleantech company, PowerSense, was Monday afternoon honoured with The Diploma of Danish Export Association and His Royal Highness Prince Henrik's Medal of Honour.

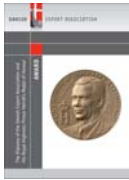
